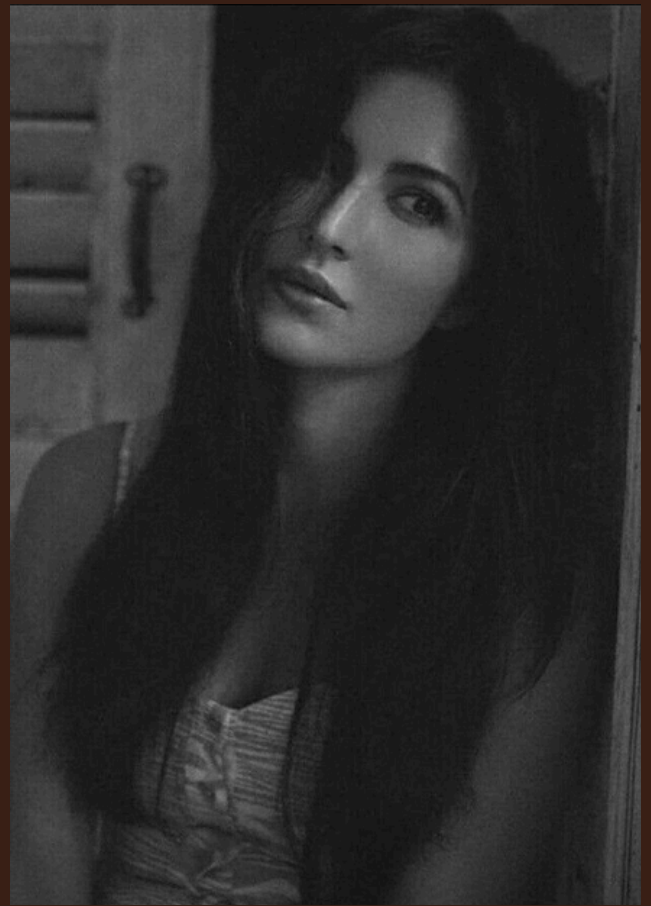
THE MAIDEN

So, Mira-ites, which version of you is showing up today?

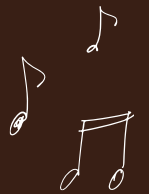

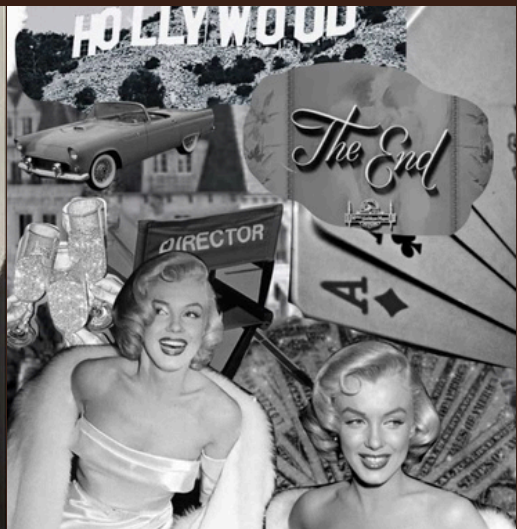

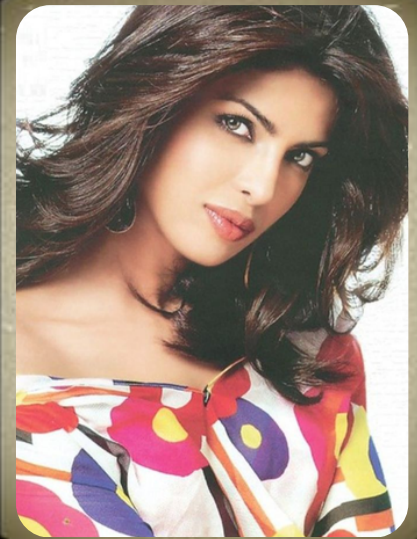

Alia Bhatt, a chameleon, effortlessly blending softness with ambition.

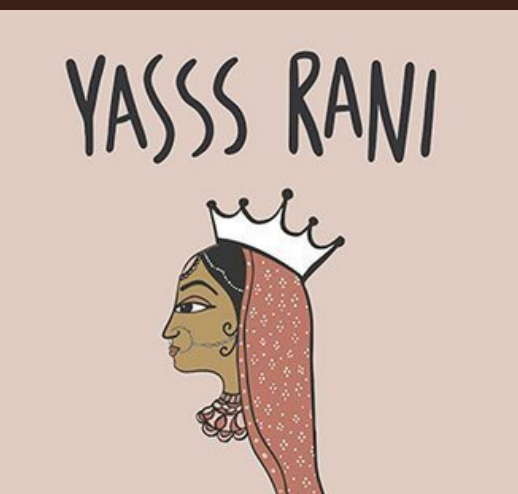
Kriti Sanon, statuesque and confident, proving intelligence and beauty go hand in hand.

For me it will always be Katrina Kaif in Jab Tak Hai Jaan.

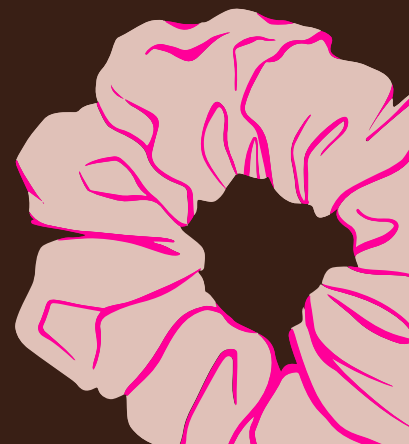




